C (Um) there are many way/s to score.  
C (The) there/'s[EW:there\_are] three way/s actually.  
C (Ah the first would probably be) the most well known would be a touchdown, which is where after the ball is kicked off from across the field (the people receive) the (ah) receiving team take/3s the ball.  
C And they have four down/s to cross a certain line, which is ten yard/s from where they start/ed.  
C (Um th\*) and then if they cross it, then they start out with another first down, which the object is to get the ball to the other end of the field into the end zone.  
C And then once you get into the end zone you score six point/s.  
C And you/'re allow/ed an extra kick into the field goal bar/s which would be one point.  
C But if you kick/ed it from farther, (then after you score/ed a touchdown like) if you did/n't score a touchdown (you still) you could still kick into the end zone if you are too far from the first down (on the fourth) on the fourth down.  
C (So) and then if you make it in that one, it/'s three point/s.  
C The last way to score which almost like never happen/3s in professional, highschool, or any football is a safety, which is where the team with the ball is tackled back in their own end zone.
